- The digital age is not a barrier but an opportunity.






## Don't assume that people know and understand the way to Jesus.

### Don't assume that people know you will show them the way to Jesus.

- MOST people think you are too busy for them. They truly don't think you would stop and show them, in the Bible, the way for them to know Jesus.
- You have to demonstrate consistently that you are willing to step away from your schedule and slowly walk with them.
- Look for opportunities to show yourself with other people in public and be available.
  Demonstrate the values you want to see.
- Get granular.
